Scrip Gift Card Program

We have started a new program at school to help raise money for extra non-budgeted items. Since the Target Take Charge of Education and Campbell's Labels for Education programs have ended, and the school is no longer receiving those donations, this program will, in effect, take their places. The basic idea of the program is that you purchase gift cards for a variety of businesses that you may already shop at (grocery, restaurants, hotels, retail, etc.) and through the Scrip program, a portion of the purchase price of the gift card is donated to Berea. You still get the full value of the gift card to use as you wish.

How does it work?

Notes from Mrs. Rehm (Grades 1-4):

- On Tuesday, Math 5 will have a test on Chapter 19.

Notes from Mr. Thurow (Grades 5-8):

- Tests this week: Tomorrow – Math Course 2, 7th & 8th gr. Reading vocabulary quiz (ch. 9-17); Wednesday – Science 7&8(human body systems); Thursday – Algebra, Language 7&8 Chapter 13 Checkup; Friday – Math Course 1
- Last Book Review is due Friday, May 5th. It will be read orally and must include a visual aide (something that applies to the book – does not need to be handmade)
- The 5th – 8th grades will be visiting St. Paul's Cathedral and the World War I exhibit at the Minnesota History Center next Thursday morning, May 4th. This is in conjunction with a Church History study for the 7th & 8th grade confirmation class, and a unit on WWI recently complete for 7th & 8th grade history.
- Next Friday, May 5th, Berea member Matt Starland and friend Steve Landgraf, a former U.S. Marine, both of whom are WWII reenactors, will be giving a WWII presentation to the 5th – 8th grade students. They will also be bringing a WWII era Scout Car for all of the students to look at.
