## Notes from Mrs. Rehm (Grades 1-4):

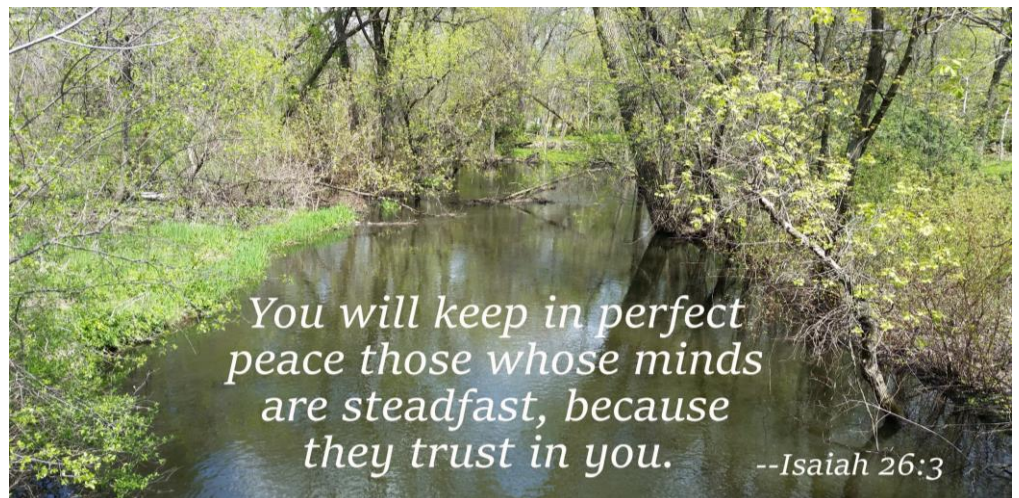
1. Students are asked to bring back the Memory folder sheets and Catechisms if they have no writing and are in good condition.
