Upper Grade Ski Trip

The 5th–8th graders will be going skiing next Thursday, Feb. 1 at Hyland Ski Area in Bloomington. They will be leaving at 8:20, eating lunch at the ski area, and returning to school by 3:00. The program includes a lesson, ski and helmet rental, and lift ticket (if student qualifies after lesson). Lunch may be purchased at the cafeteria that day, or students may bring their own lunch. Students should dress appropriately for that day including warm, water-resistant gloves, and snow pants. Dressing in layers is recommended. All students will be wearing helmets, so hats are not needed. At this point we have six adult skiers along to chaperone. That is also plenty for driving students, but if more parents want to come along to chaperone in the lodge, or just to learn to ski, you are welcome. **Important note:** Each student needs to have a waiver form filled out and signed by a parent. These forms were included in last week's folder. **If you have not done so yet, please fill out this form and return it to school. Your child will not be able to ski without a signed waiver form.**
